This 100% cotton textile features a distinctive diagonal drill weave, providing a structural, three-dimensional topography that traditional canvases cannot replicate. While the fabric is exceptionally dense and durable, the natural cotton fibers maintain a sophisticated softness and a firm handle, bridging the gap between raw grit and fine art elegance.
